## Classroom Projects – 100's

### 101. Mrs. Eichert's Class Project - Jackson Pollock Painting #1

*Mrs. Eichert's class read and studied the techniques of American abstract expressionist painter Jackson Pollock. Like Pollock we used house paint applied in motion to create two "Action Jackson" paintings on stretched canvas. Each has a unique color palette and is signed by the entire class. Pollock is also associated with the introduction of the All-over style of painting which avoids any points of emphasis or identifiable parts within the whole canvas and therefore we will leave it up to our art benefactors to decide which orientation to display the works in. The two pieces will be auctioned separately.*

*A Fort Ross bench decoupaged in a comic-book theme.*

### 104. Ms. Damico's Class Project

*A beautiful Southwest inspired mosaic. It is a colorful blend of ceramic tile and glass droplets depicting a sunburst radiating over the Sonoma hills. It measures approximately 30" x 36" . The students in class set glass and tile. A parent volunteer and experienced mosaic artist planned and executed and completed an amazing mosaic for indoors or outdoors.*

### 105. Mrs. Howe's Class Project

*The children in Mrs. Howe's class decided they wanted to make a quilt with an outer space theme. They actually did a good part of the sewing with some adult help on the sewing machine. They selected the fabrics that inspired them and pulled together a very vibrant, happy quilt. It is roughly 53 inches wide by 66 inches long. The pattern, called stacked coins, was widely used in Amish communities for smaller quilts. It was lovingly assembled and quilted by Maggie Miller, mother of one of the students.*

### 106. Ms. Richman's Class Project

*Hand Painted Pair of Wooden Tables Depicting Beautiful Fruits. The twenty three children from Mrs. Richman's second and third grade class, plus Mrs. Richman herself, painted one on one with Coordinating Artist, and Evan's Grandma, Ginger Irwin. Each artist chose his or her own fruit design created by Ginger, and then copied individually by eye the outline and filled the interior with the colors of his or her choice. Painted with acrylic paint with three coats of varathane, these 20 inch tall and 24 inch by 12 inch tables, will have a long and happy life with the lucky winning bidder.*

### 107. Mrs. Hertzberg's Class Project

*Tree of Growing Hands: Hands of children in an array of plum colors and diverse patterns and textures, growing up and out from Mother Nature's trunk. The trunk is like the shape of a woman's hourglass, bosom and torso, pedestal bowl -- holding yet simultaneously releasing her children, the leaves, that sprouted from her. This wall hanging is truly a labor of love, inspired by the children's hands of Ms.Hertzberg's class, created by Victoria Campana, mother of kindergartner Zoe, and assisted by Kallie, mother of first grader Maya. May it bring the love that inspired it into your home.*

### 108. Mrs. Lewis' Class Project

*The students have photographed the school through their own eyes. The photos and portraits have been assembled into a collage and printed together as a 20" x 42" giclee on canvas.*

### 109. Mrs. Shelley's Class Project - Fort Ross Collage Watercolor

*A watercolor collage of the Sonoma Coast at Fort Ross. Phaedra Achor will be assembling and framing this once my students paint their watercolor landscapes inspired by our recent trip.*

### 110. Ms. Caudle's Class Project

*"Through Our Eyes" Downtown Petaluma as Viewed by 7th and 8th-Graders, A Photo Essay*  
The seventh- and eighth-graders in Carrie Caudle's class learned the basics of photography from visiting artist (and Jean Remy's dad), Gerard Lion. We then ventured downtown to practice our new skills--taking photos of our town from every angle we could imagine. Finally, we juried the hundreds of photos as a class, nominating our favorites based on the elements and principles of design which made them exemplary photographs. We have displayed a sampling of this collection in reclaimed frames for use as wall art and in greeting card sets. We hope you enjoy them and imagine our class laughing, pondering, and creating as you see each piece of downtown Petaluma through our eyes.

### 111. Ms. Rocco/Radford & Ms. Caudle's Class Project

*Ms. Rocco/Radford's class and Ms. Caudle's classes learned about the history of block printing--and then practiced a variety of techniques as every seventh- and eighth-grader carved her/his very own block. All of our designs were inspired by nature in some way, but the subjects and styles of these designs exhibit a range as wide as the tremendous variety in our wonderful group of middle school students. Serena Radford's class has printed a sampling of these exquisite designs and displayed them in reclaimed frames for use as wall art and in greeting card sets.*

### 112. Mr. Wicks' Class Project

*Nature themed mosaic tile mirror created by Mr. Wicks' Class with assistance and inspiration from local artists (and Mary Collins parents) Gerald and Kelly Hong. Students collected various objects from school nature trail and imprinted them in clay, complimenting their studies in Native American Culture.*
